1 Growth or decline in underrepresented populations (Latina/o, African Ancestry, Pacific Islander, Filipino)

Explanation: In 2009-10 we experienced a significant increase in the number of Hispanic and Filipino students along with a decrease in the number of Pacific Islanders and significant decrease of the number of Black students. This drop in Black students could be due to the poor economy because these students must work to survive and may not have the money or time available to attend school.

Explanation: When comparing the success rate of Hispanics, Filipino, Pacific Islander and Black students the average is 72, which falls within the parameter of 70-75 disclosed in the master plan. This success rate is slighlty higher than 2008-9. When reviewing the data more closedly we see our success rate for Filipino students jumped from 67% in 2008-9 to 79% in 2009-10. Success rate for Hispanic students dropped from 68% in 2008-9 to 66% in 2009-10. Our Pacific Islander success rate was consistent 100% in both years. Unfortunately our Black students success rate dropped from 52% in 2008-9 to 43% in 2009-10.

After a significant rise in WSCH and enrollment from 2007-8 to 2009-10 our numbers plateaued in 2009-10. However our productivity jumped from 411 in 2008-9 to 587 in 2009-10. This can be explained due to the budget cuts that eliminated most of our evening program. It appears that instead of losing these students they combined with our day students. our instructors allowed all qualified students into classes so our classes were extremely large when compared to private massage schools. Our retention rate increased from 89% in 2008-9 to 93% in 2009-10. Where our succedd rates increased from 72% in 2008-9 to 73% in 2009-10
